# JNZPF Scholarships

## Information and Application form

## Japan-New Zealand Partnership Foundation (JNZPF) Scholarships

JNZPF offers scholarships to applicants who wish to foster positive relationships with students from different cultures and serve as role models for other students of IPU New Zealand in academic and student life. Students enrolling in any IPU New Zealand degree or diploma programme may apply for the JNZPF scholarship.

There are two levels of scholarships: full or half. Scholarships are awarded based on achievement of merit / Excellence grades in NCEA Level 3, and demonstration of strong interpersonal and leadership capabilities.

The scholarship covers the tuition portion only. The terms and conditions of the scholarship are stated in the form of a contract between JNZPF, IPU New Zealand, and the recipient for a fixed term for the provision of the subsidy of tuition fees.

Please note the scholarship applies to the tuition fees only: all students are still required to pay the facility fee.

### 1. Terms and conditions for recipients of scholarship

- 1.1 Recipients of scholarships are required to sign a contract that clarifies the terms and conditions for acceptance of the scholarship.
- 1.2 Scholarships are renewed annually for up to three years for the degree, or less as required for completion of other academic programmes. Compliance with required terms and conditions will be reviewed and eligibility for renewal determined on an annual basis.
- 1.3 Individuals receiving a scholarship award are expected to maintain a strong average (B) in all papers/subjects/ courses undertaken.
- 1.4 All scholarship recipients are expected to:
  - 1.4.1 maintain 80% attendance in all programmes enrolled,
  - 1.4.2 be role models in academic and student life for others at IPU New Zealand,
  - 1.4.3 demonstrate leadership skills, and growth thereof,
  - 1.4.4 develop ways to assist students from various countries to appreciate and share their own culture along with other students, and
  - 1.4.5 ensure that both they and any students in their charge are engaged in activities at both IPU New Zealand and in the community of Palmerston North.
- 1.5 Recipients of scholarships are required to be available to contribute up to 5 hours per week to IPU New Zealand through an internal internship doing work such as helping with field trips, supervising students in the computer laboratories or the library, assisting students in class or on a one-to-one basis and assisting in open campus events. Internal internships are seen as providing personal development and leadership to recipients.
- 1.6 Accommodation (room and board) is not included in a scholarship award. All recipients of scholarships must pay their own room and board if living in IPU New Zealand accommodation.

### 2. Application procedure for the scholarship

- 2.1 **Please notify IPU New Zealand of your NCEA Level 3 Merit or Excellence achievement.**
- 2.2 If you wish to apply for a scholarship, you must submit a short essay on the topic stated below and include it with your application for admission
  - 2.2.1 How you have helped others, how you have developed your leadership skills, and how you intend to ensure you are actively involved in activities at IPU New Zealand.
  - 2.2.2 If you are applying for postgraduate study (Master or Postgraduate Diploma of International Studies), you must also provide a statement (approximately 1000 words) of your prior work experience and/or study and how it will contribute to your postgraduate study at IPU New Zealand.
  - 2.2.3 You must ask two personal referees, one academic and one character, to provide written references. Referee's must have known you for at least one year and cannot be related to you. Referees should mail their reference directly to NZ Recruitment, IPU New Zealand, Private Bag 11021, Palmerston North, within a week of submitting your application.
