## The IPU Archives Collection

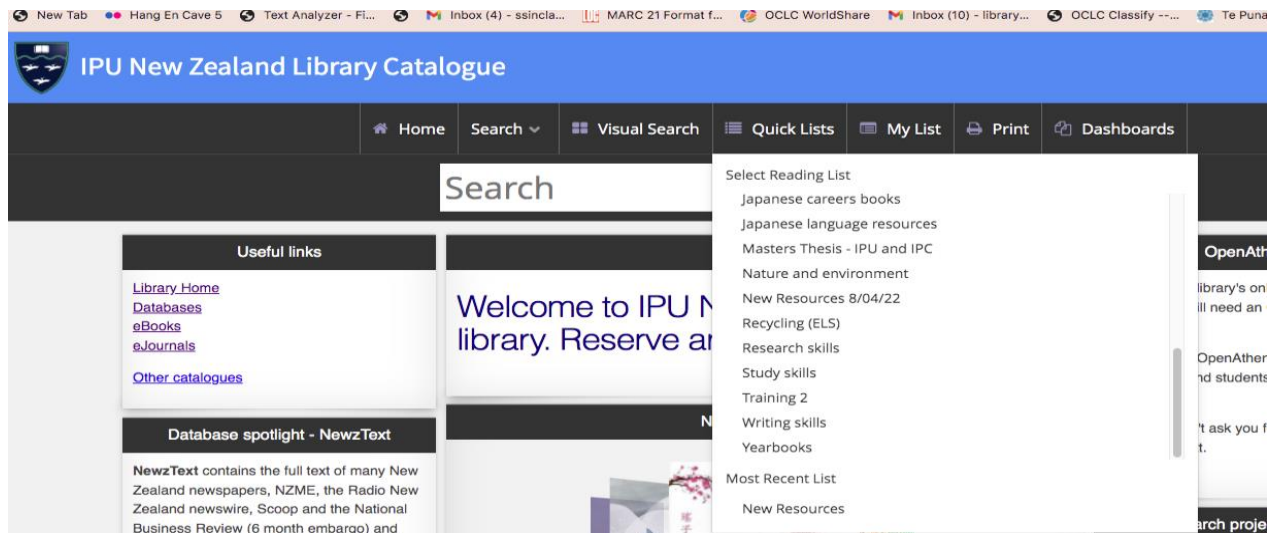
