- Mental health awareness week 18-24 Sept.

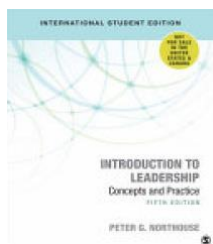

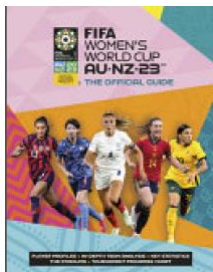

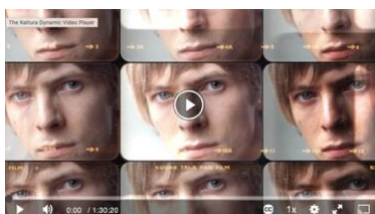
