

SEARCHING THE LIBRARY CATALOGUE




To find things using the **library catalogue** (books, DVDs, journals), click on the **Search the catalogue** link on the Library website library.ipu.ac.nz:



Then enter your search words into the search box:



To be more specific with your search you might like to use the **Advanced Search**. To get to the Advanced Search, click on the drop down arrow next to Search and choose Advanced Search.




From within the Advanced Search, you can search for an author (**creator**), or you can combine a keyword (**title**) and author (**creator**) if you're looking for a specific book.



FINDING IT ON THE SHELF

Once you have found something you like the look of, you will need to find it on the shelf.





- 1. Check for a **green number 1** which means a copy is on the shelf. If you see a red zero then no copies are currently available and you will need to reserve it.
- **2.** Look for the **Collection** the item belongs to, for example, Introductory Non-Fiction, Movies, Fiction. Go to the shelves that hold this collection.
- 3. The **Classification** tells you where to find the item on the shelf.
